

SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICTS

San Joaquin County is divided into five supervisory districts which are approximately equal in population.

After each United States census, the boundaries of each district are changed by the Board of Supervisors, if necessary, to reflect equal population in each area of representation.

Members of the Board are elected on a non-partisan ballot to represent the district in which they reside and serve a 4-year term. The chairman is selected by the Board members to preside for one year.

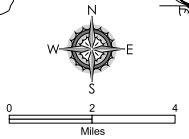
